Solar Panel System Update July 7, 2023

The Solar Implementation Task Force is pleased to provide an update on the solar panel system which was approved at a special congregational meeting on January 22, 2023.

In early February, the project moved ahead with Synergy Renewable Systems out of Stoughton and an order was placed for the solar inverters. With an anticipated 24 to 28-week lead time for delivery, the estimated timeframe for installation is between July 20 and August 17, 2023.

Meantime, preparation work has continued. The contract with Synergy was signed and 50% of the total cost was invoiced and paid from donor funds. The 57 solar panel modules were picked up from Solar for Good and are in storage at Synergy in Stoughton awaiting delivery of the inverters.

On April 10, the south-facing roof on FLC was replaced and an assessment made for structural integrity. All went smoothly and there was no need to spend any of the contingency funds. The location of the power connector has been identified and an application has been submitted to Alliant Energy for final approval and hookup.

As installation and activation of the system draws near, the Solar Implementation Task Force will be providing additional communication about the project. The system is expected to provide approximately 28% of the electrical needs of McFarland Lutheran Church and reduce the annual utility cost by an estimated \$4400.
