

PLEASE HELP BEAUTIFY THE CHURCH...IT'S ONLY A FEW TIMES A YEAR!

Hello. The Decorative Arts Committee needs help. Let me explain what we do and maybe you can help us.

- We decorate the church with flowers for holidays...Lilies and spring blooms for Easter, Poinsettias for Christmas, and Geraniums for Pentecost.
- Flowers are ordered, work times are arranged, people show up, flowers are put in place and watered.
- For Christmas we also decorate the trees, set up the Nativity and Manger scenes, and put out the table decorations.
- We DO NOT put up or take down the banners which also decorate the church; the Banners Committee does that.
- We DO NOT make centerpieces or floral arrangements; we just arrange the potted flowers which have been delivered. You do not have to be creative.

We really need the help and it's only for Easter, Christmas, and Pentecost. If you can or cannot do physical work, you could be a coordinator. This would involve ordering the flowers and/or sending emails to set up work times. There is a book that tells you everything you need to do and there are people who can help with anything you have a question about. Please consider helping. You could be coordinator (or choose one thing, like ordering the flowers or sending emails), or choose just to help decorate for Christmas or put out flowers for Easter. It's up to you and very flexible. It is a relatively short answer. There are a few church staff positions that remain open, along with the employment expenses related to those positions. Unfortunately, the senior pastor position remains open as we know. Just recently, we filled the administrative administrative position with Heather Wedan. This position had been open for a number of months. Church giving is slightly under budget by approximately 3%. If it were not for these staff openings and adding in the shortfall in giving, our year-to-date results would be closer to the budgeted loss of \$19,500.
