Sanctuary Projector Update

You may have noticed that one of our sanctuary projectors is not working. We have been working to resolve the issue. These projectors are nearly ten years old, this projector model is no longer in production, and service for this old technology isn't available or cost effective. We are in the process of gaining proposals to replace our two sanctuary projectors. It will take a few weeks to finalize a replacement option and to schedule this installation.

The good news, projector technology has improved a lot since these were first installed. Our new projectors will be laser projectors (not bulbs), they will provide a brighter and more vivid image, they will last much longer than bulb projectors, and they will be more reliable and require less maintenance than our current projectors.

Worship AV Volunteer Sign-Ups & Training Opportunities

There is a need to grow our worship AV volunteer team. Recent training opportunities have helped involve new people. Thank you for your continued volunteer efforts!

How do I volunteer and learn how to run the worship slides, sound, and video? You can still simply sign-up on the online Worship Assistants Sign-Up – 8AM Worship Volunteers & 10AM Worship Volunteers on the church website.

There are now 2 AV volunteer sign-up slots: **AV Leader AND AV Assistant/Training** - If you are a regular, experienced AV volunteer, you can sign-up as normal under "AV Leader" and you might possibly help teach or assist someone less familiar with the technology.

- If you are brand new, or are still learning, you can sign-up under "AV Assistant/ Training" to gain live training and experience during the worship service.
- We would like to move towards a model where we have 2 people in the AV booth for each worship service to teach more volunteers, and to better run the various moving parts of slides, sound balance, video production, and the occasional troubleshooting issue.

Handbell/Choirchime Update

Did you know that the first set of handbells (3 octaves) were purchased by MLC in 1980? The choirchimes were purchased in 1996 and the 4th octave of handbells were purchased in 1997. Like all musical instruments, the handbells and choirchimes require periodic refurbishment – ours have never been serviced. Therefore, we have sent them to the manufacturer for refurbishment (this includes polishing, tuning, replacing worn/broken parts and repairing the instrument cases). We have scheduled the refurbishment to begin the week of April 15 to receive a manufacturer 10% discount on basic maintenance. The tables have been taken down so that the table covers can be cleaned. The MLC Handbell Choir looks forward to next Fall to begin the new musical season with the refurbished handbells and choirchimes!!

At the March 19 Council meeting, Council members discussed the importance of all the many devoted volunteers in our congregation who make it possible for McFarland Lutheran Church to carry out our mission: to share God's word, to show God's love, to serve God's world. The contributions of our many volunteers cannot be overstated or even comprehensively listed. We volunteer because we love God and because we truly are His hands and His feet reaching out to help and serve others. God gives us the personal gifts, the strength, and the opportunities to serve our congregation and each other. The Council wants to **SINCERELY THANK** the many people who volunteer in so many different capacities here at McFarland Lutheran Church. We also want to encourage all members to recognize their individual Godgiven gifts and to share those gifts with others whenever possible!

Q's & A's After Uganda Presentation

At the April 6 and 7 weekend services, presentations were given on our recent Uganda mission trip. Afterwards we presenters were asked several common questions, and we have provided answers below.

Q1: If I want to support the Uganda mission, what is most needed? There are so many needs, all important and helpful to someone. If you try to use logic to determine which is most important, you'll discover there are good reasons to support each and every need. Rather than using logic, just follow your heart. Whether you want to help supply clean water, support education for children or adults, provide vocational training, clothe a child, provide medical supplies, feed children, or support school construction, do what appeals to your heart!

Q2: How do I sponsor a child's education? Go to the Hope 4 Kids International website by typing H4KI.org into your browser. Then click on the Sponsor a Child button at the top of the page. From there you can select a child to sponsor by filtering students by Country, Gender, and Age Range.

Q3: Will McFarland Lutheran be raising funds for more wells? Yes. Another Walk-4-Water is scheduled on Sept. 21. The website to register for the walk and / or make a contribution will be going live in the coming weeks. Details will be published in the newsletter and on the church website as they become available.

Q4: What happens to the produce and animals that are given to us at the well dedication ceremony? The H-4-K staff in Uganda distributes the goods to local needy families or to H-4-K employees.

Q5: When will there be another Uganda mission trip? We don't know yet. The Global Mission Team hopes to get back to one mission trip per year to Uganda, traditionally in March. H-4-K has not put together the schedule for 2025 trips, but we are hoping they will accommodate a trip in March 2025. H-4-K has also been running 2 trips to Uganda in July and one in November, and anyone can attend one of these trips by signing up on the H4KI website.
